- 2) AoR have an arrow diameter limit and no arrows greater than 23XX nor any all carbon arrows may be used.
- 3) Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the school grounds, including the car park area.
- 4) The organiser reserves the right to modify the published target lists on the day and without prior notification.
- 5) The organiser reserves the right to remove a round where only one or two archers are registered for the round in favour of a round that has three or more people on the waiting list.
- 6) The Archery GB / GNAS Dress Code applies.
- 7) The Judge's decision is final.
- 8) Archers of Raunds and Manor School and Sports College, Raunds, cannot accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury howsoever sustained whilst on any property belonging to Manor School and Sports College. Entry to the tournament will be considered as full acceptance of these conditions by all competitors or club members.
- 9) All arrows must be accounted for at the end of the shoot. Any lost arrow must be immediately reported to the event organiser and the shooting field marked accordingly.
- 10) No entries or substitutions will be accepted following the published entry close date.
- 11) Junior archers under the age of fourteen must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times whilst at the shoot.
