

Bow style criteria for competitions held in Northamptonshire	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recurve as per AGB guidelines – rule 202 2. Compound as per AGB guidelines – rule 207 3. Barebow as per AGB guidelines – rule 204 4. Longbow as per AGB guidelines – rule 206 5. Flatbow – bow with shelf, no recurve at limbs, wooden arrows with feather fletching, no string walking allowed, fingers must be in contact with arrow. Finger position must remain the same throughout competition. If metal arrows are used then reverts to Barebow 6. Traditional – bow with recurve (with or without shelf), wooden arrows with feather fletching, no string walking allowed, fingers must be in contact with arrow. Finger position must remain the same throughout competition. If metal arrows are used then reverts to Barebow style.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Archery GB / GNAS cards must be provided at the Tournament registration. 2) AoR have an arrow limit and no arrows greater than 23XX may be used 3) Smoking is not permitted anywhere on school property including car park areas 4) The organiser reserves the right to modify the published target lists on the day and without prior notification 5) The organiser reserves the right to remove a round where only one or two archers are registered for the round in favour of a round that has three or more people on the waiting list 6) Archery GB dress regulations apply (Rule 307) 7) The Judges decision is final 8) Archers of Raunds and Manor School and Sports college, Raunds cannot accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury howsoever sustained whilst on any property belonging to Manor School and Sports college. Entry to the Tournament will be considered as full acceptance of these conditions by all competitors and club members 9) All arrows must be accounted for at the end of the shoot. Any lost arrow must be immediately reported to the event organiser and the shooting field marked accordingly 10) No entries or substitutions will be accepted following the published entry close date 11) Junior archers under the age of eighteen must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times whilst at the shoot
