Awards:	Recurve, Compound, Barebow and Traditional for Open 50+, Open, Ladies 50+, Ladies, Junior Open and Junior Girls. Single and Double Session. First score(s) count. 1st, 2nd and 3rd where 3 or more archers are shooting otherwise gold for 1st only
Juniors	Ages for junior archers are subject to AGB rule 308 (b): 308(b) Age Groups (i) An archer may compete in a junior age group where the tournament take place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category. (e.g. if they turned 17 in a year they can compete in an U18 category, but they cannot turn 18 in the year) An archer may compete for an award shooting a round in a higher age group than their own.
Dress	Record status has been granted for this event, competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations – rule 307.
Closing Date:	7 days prior to competition date or when shoot is full
General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR):	When you enter competitions, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bowstyle, Date of Birth/Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
The Archery GB (GNAS) Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy requires that any person wishing to engage in any type of photography, filming or videoing at any event must register their intent with the event organiser. Conditions of entry	
1)	Archery GB / GNAS cards must be produced at the event if requested
2)	AoR have an arrow limit and no arrows greater than 23XX may be used
3)	Smoking is not permitted anywhere on school property including car park areas
4)	The organiser reserves the right to modify the published target lists on the day and without prior notification
5)	The organiser reserves the right to remove a round where only one or two archers are registered for the round in favour of a round that has three or more people on the waiting list
6)	Archery GB dress regulations apply (Rule 307)
7)	The Judges decision is final
8)	Archers of Raunds and Manor School and Sports college, Raunds cannot accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury howsoever sustained whilst on any property belonging to Manor School and Sports college. Entry to the tournament will be considered as full acceptance of these conditions by all competitors and club members
9)	All arrows must be accounted for at the end of the shoot. Any lost arrow must be immediately reported to the event organiser and the shooting field marked accordingly
10)	No entries or substitutions will be accepted following the published entry close date
11)	Junior archers under the age of eighteen must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times whilst at the shoot
